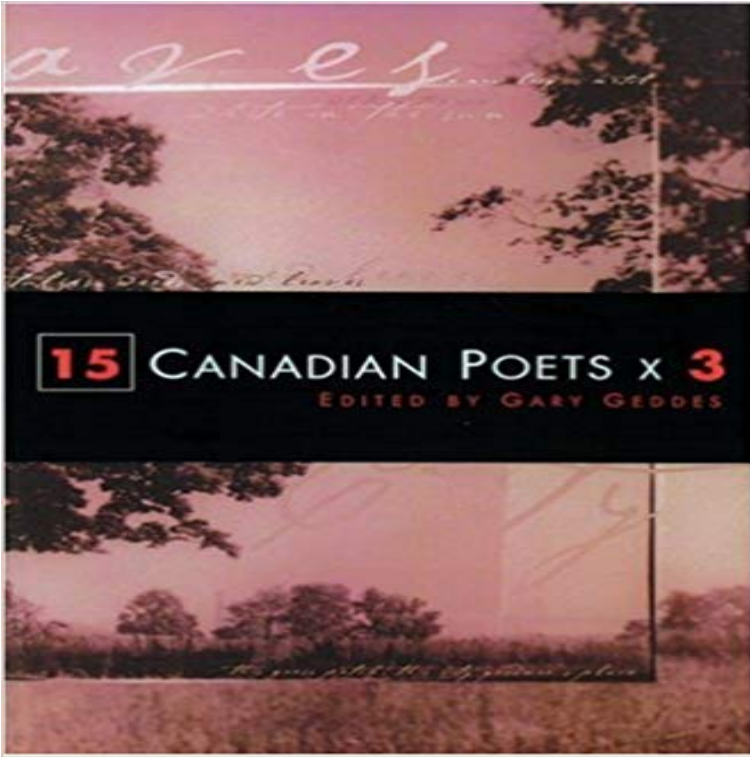


15 Canadian Poets x 3
