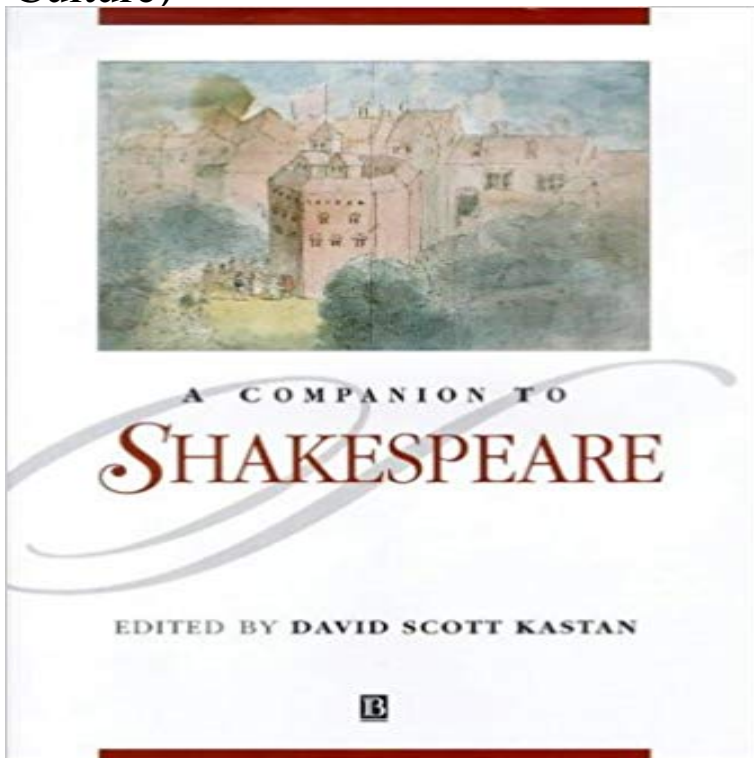


# A Companion to Shakespeare (Blackwell Companions to Literature and Culture)
