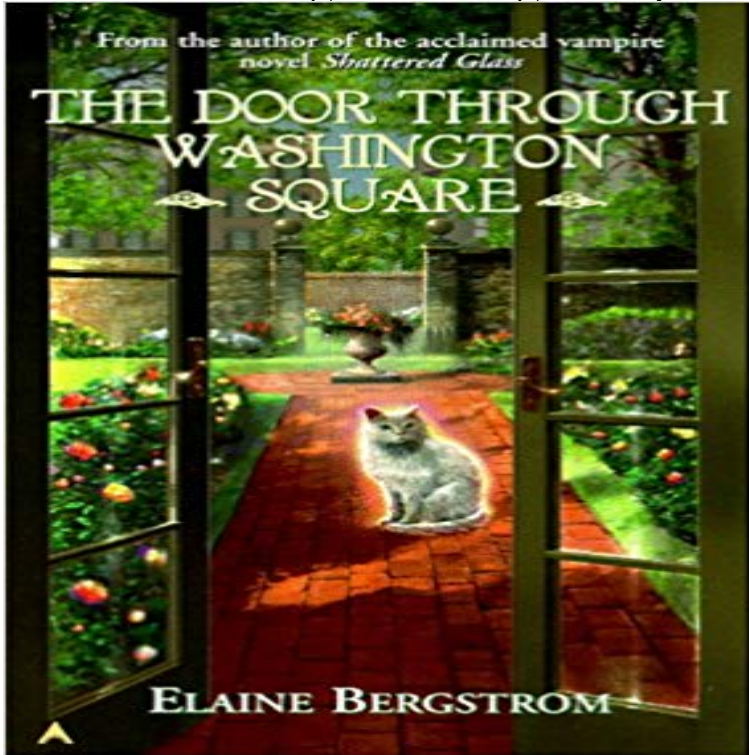


The Door through Washington Square
