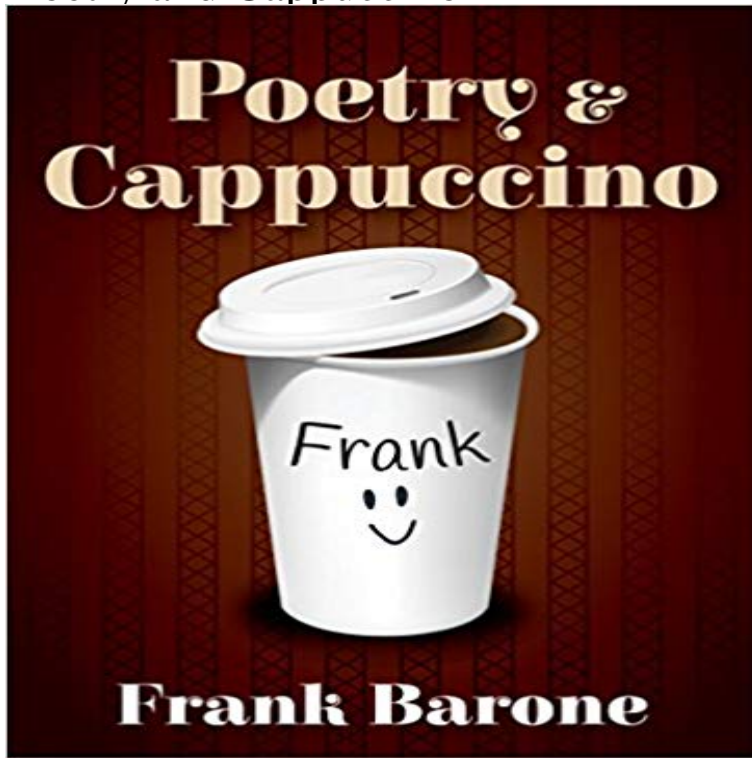


## Poetry and Cappuccino
