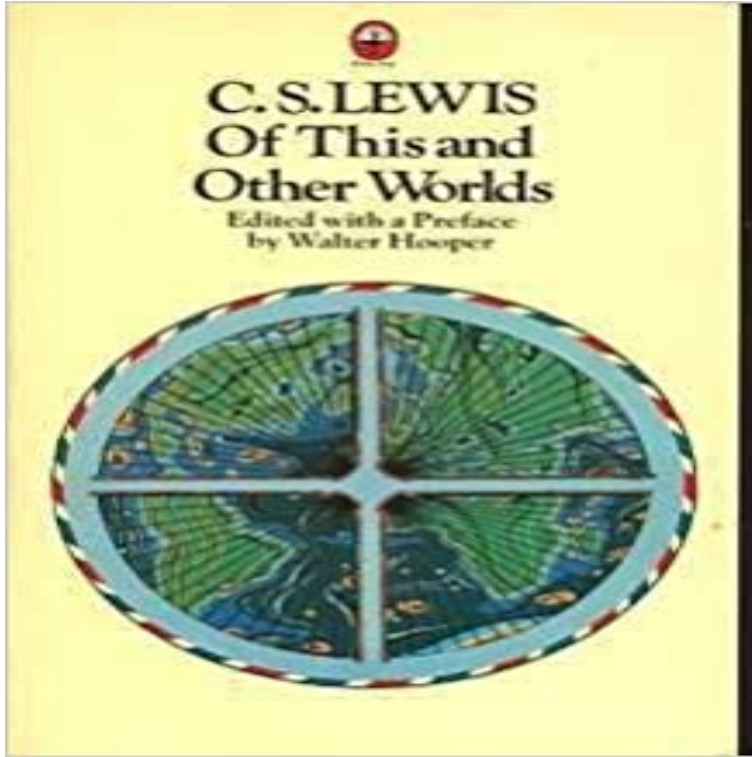


Of This and Other Worlds
