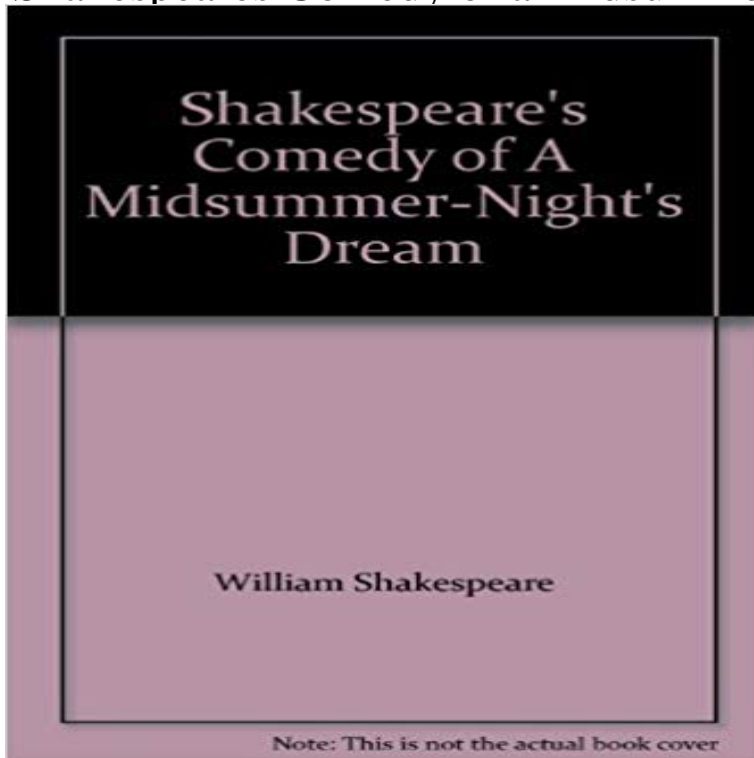

The play is one of Shakespeares most popular works for the stage and is widely performed across the world.
