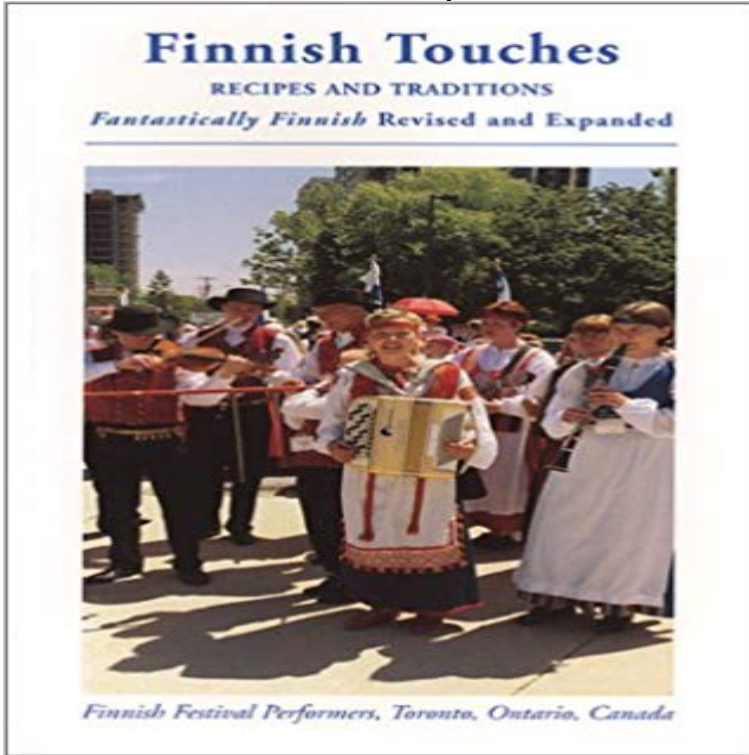


Finnish Touches: Recipes & Traditions
