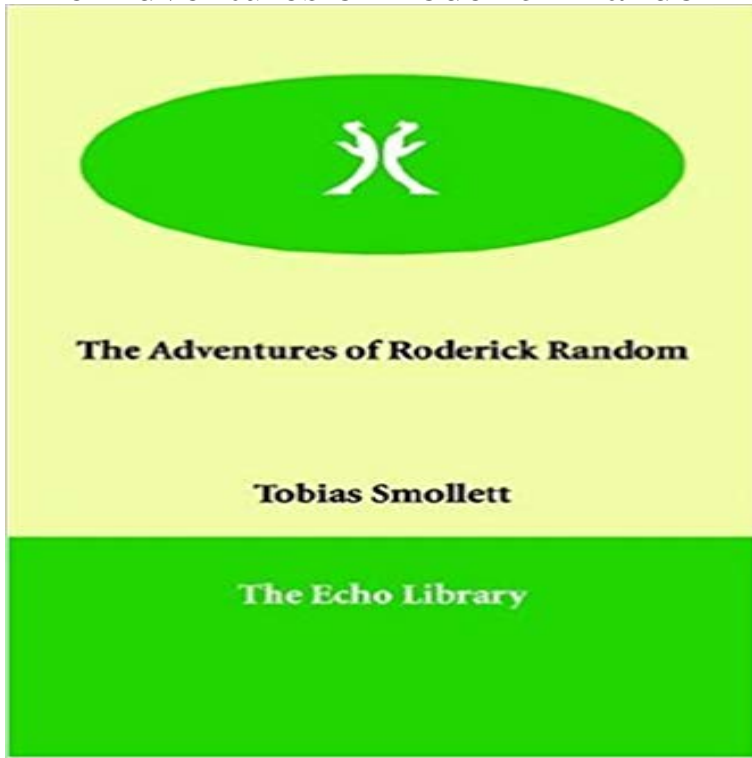


The Adventures of Roderick Random
