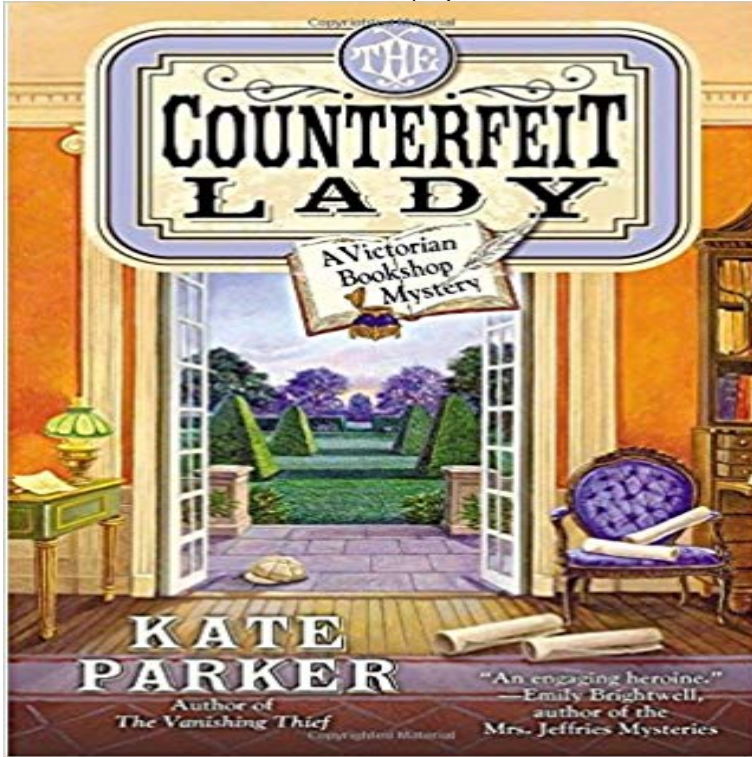


The Counterfeit Lady (A Victorian Bookshop Mystery)
