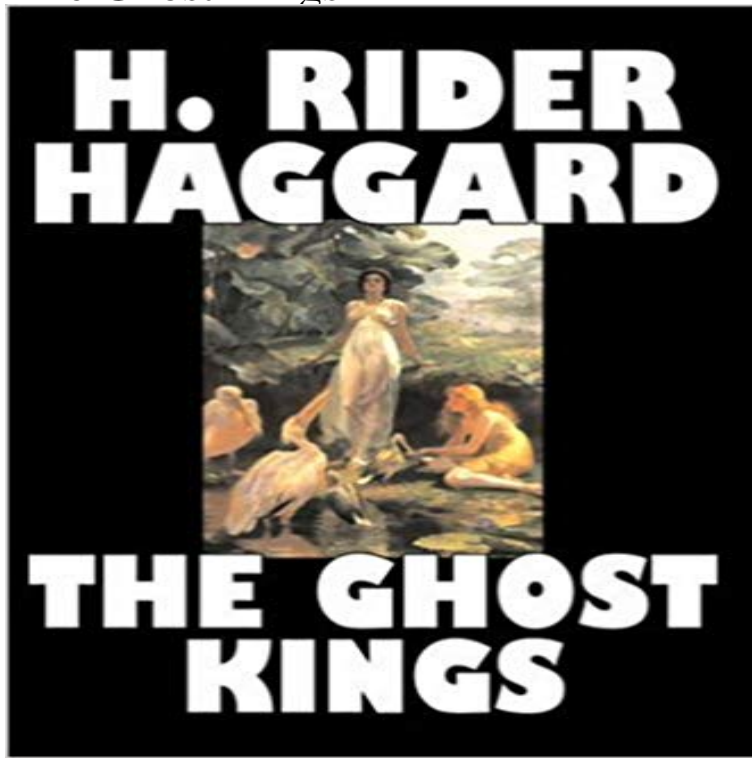


The Ghost Kings
