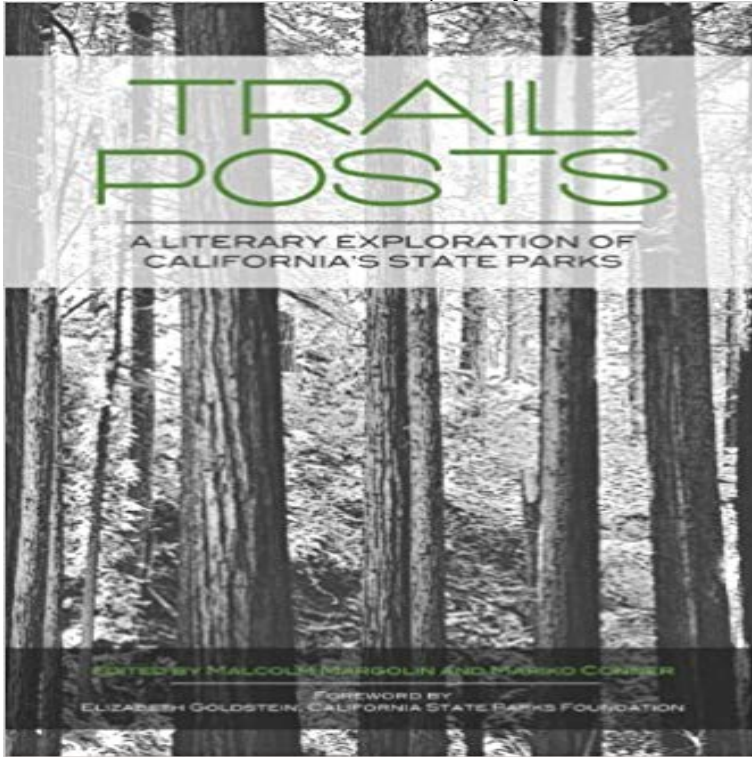


# Trail Posts: A Literary Exploration of California's State Parks
