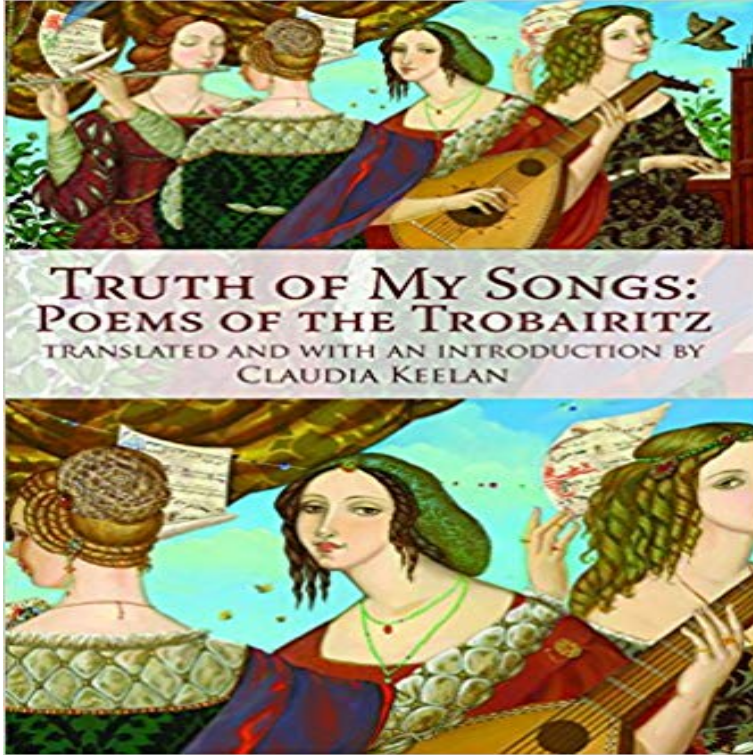


# Truth of My Songs: Poems of the Trobairitz

Together, the poems present a profound argument for and against the notion of fin amor, the pure or fine notion of love, invented by their male counterparts. Tragic, raucous, vulgar, silly, and strange, the poems of the trobairitz prove that women's history has been recorded since the first woman raised her voice and lifted a pen.
