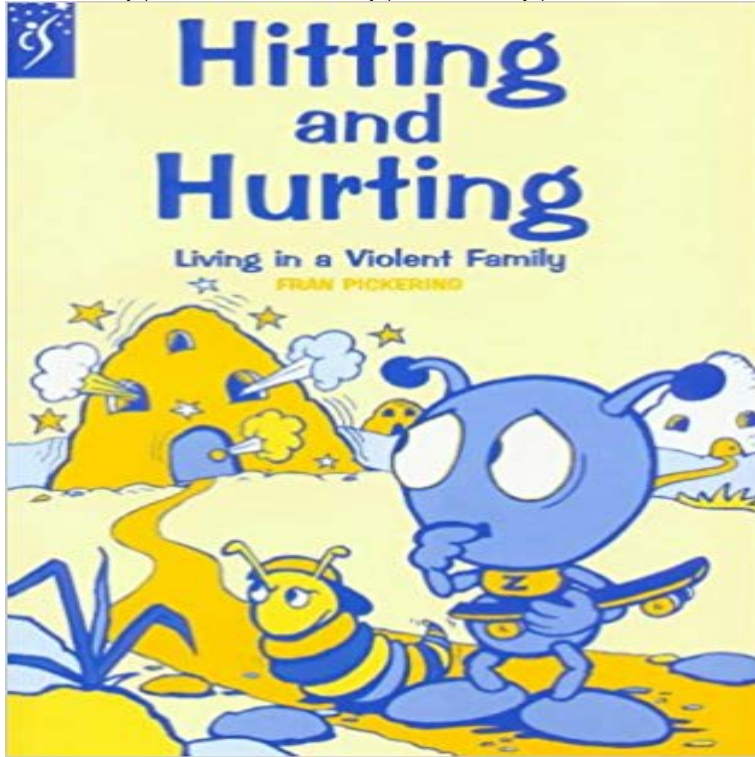


Hitting and Hurting: Living in a Violent Family
