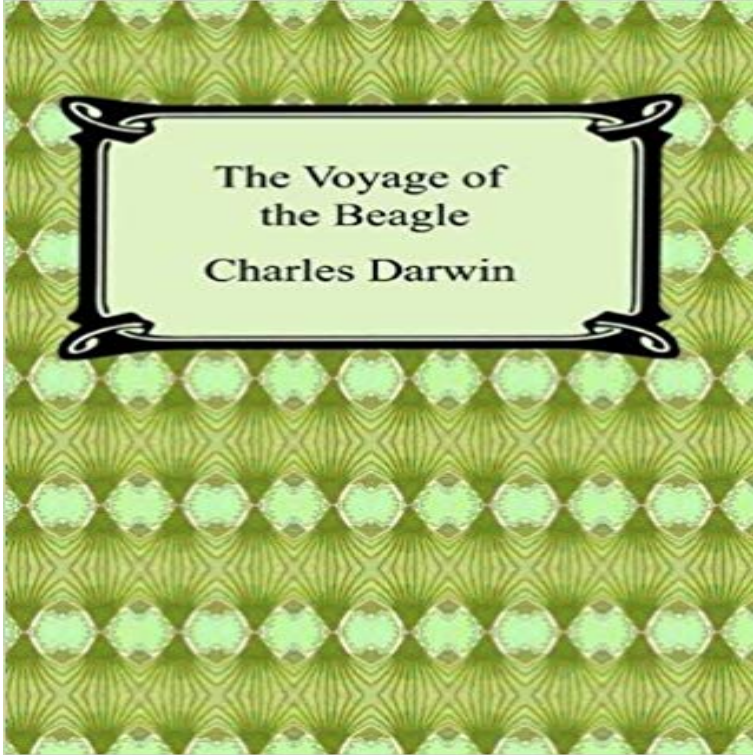


The Voyage of the Beagle [with Biographical Introduction]
