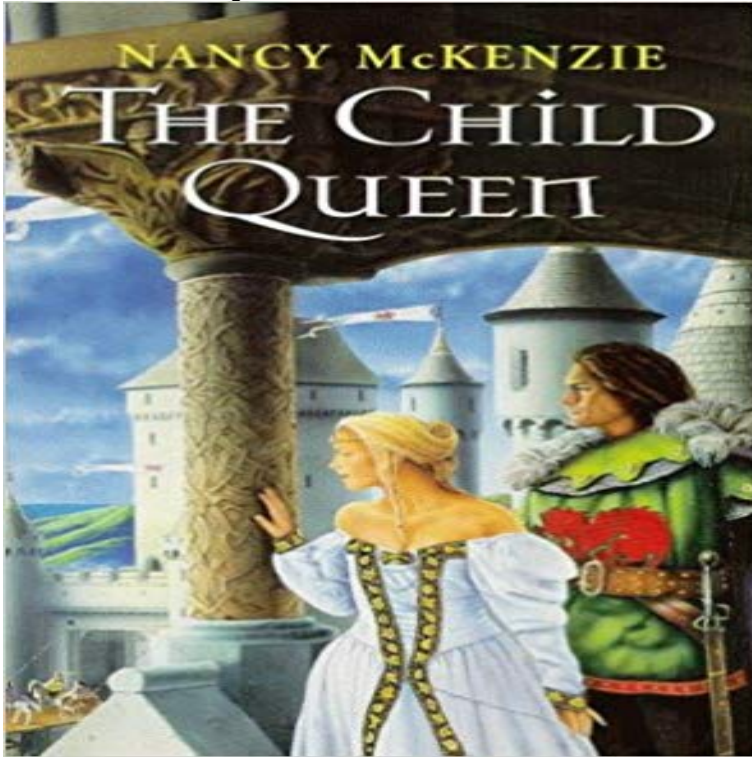


The Child Queen
