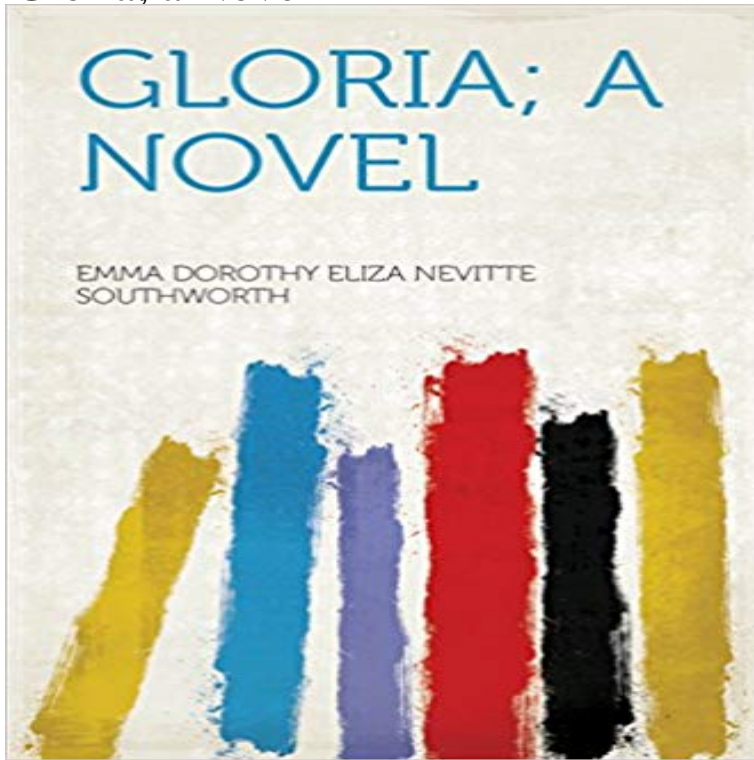


Gloria; a Novel
